you have 5 years of CSRS and/or FICA service, do not count any CSRS Interim or CSRS Offset service CSRS Interim is a version of the CSRS that was established pending the creation of the FERS CSRS Interim employees on January 1, 1987, who had at least 5 years of potentially creditable civilian service as of December 31, 1986,

Retirement Facts 1

If you leave Federal employment before you are eligible for an "immediate" annuity, you can either have your deductions returned or leave the money in the retirement fund If you have completed at least 5 years of civilian service and you leave your money in the fund, you will be entitled to a "deferred" annuity at age 62

no longer works for the University Vesting in TSERS occurs once you have completed a minimum of five (5) years of membership service Membership service is earned as you work and contribute to the Retirement System each month Once you are vested and meet the age and years of service requirements, you may draw a monthly,

Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for Non-Citizens

you're a non-citizen and want to apply for SSI benefits, contact us to see if you're eligible NOTE: If you entered the United States on or after Aug 22, 1996, then you may not be eligible for SSI for the first five years as a lawfully admitted permanent resident, even if you have 40 credits of earnings Seven-year limit for some non-citizens

WHEN YOUR FRS EMPLOYMENT ENDS

If you do not have enough FRS-covered service to be fully vested in your Investment Plan account, your unvested balance will be moved to a suspense account If you return to FRS-covered employment within 5 years from your date of termination, your unvested balance, plus earnings, will be reinstated from the suspense account Warning!

Pensions & Benefits Between PERS or ABP

If you are a State employee and had 25 or more years of service credit in either the PERS or ABP before July 1, 1997, you will have the State Health Benefits Program premiums paid in full by the State regardless of when you retire Employees who attained 25 years of service credit after July 1, 1997 (August 1, 1997, for those who
